Context:

Extension activities is an aspect of education that focus on community and neighbourhood service. By providing extension activities in the neighbourhood for the holistic development of the society, PDKVCET instills social value and obligations in the faculty members and students. The issues faced by their own society are largely unknown to pupils in today's culture. As a result, it is understood that students need to be kept aware of society, and extracurricular activities are made required for them. The extension programmes are organized each year for various areas near the college. The extension activity, which is a part of the services and curriculum, is being completed by all pupils. Students are encouraged to plan their own programmes and events for the public in order to help them comprehend the underlying issues affecting society. The Students are also allowed to take up surveys in the villages to understand the problems faced by the people, so as to provide solutions through innovative research or through extension activities. 




